



Dear Bride and Groom,

I hope that at this stage your wedding plans are all coming together and you are looking forward to your big day.

It is with much regret that we have to make a change to the advertised pricing structure at the hotel. As you may be aware the cost of Beef has recently increased massively and we have sourced various suppliers in order to keep costs as low as possible.

However, the continuation of the ban on importing Beef from places such as Argentina has meant that the cost of British Beef has inflated and will not be reducing in 2010.

The advertised price of The Rogerthorpe Sirloin of Beef will be increased from January 2009 to **£20.75 per person** until further notice.

No other prices will be changed and I am disappointed that we must change the price of the Sirloin of Beef as I know how popular this dish is.

At this stage we will not be changing the pricing structure for 2011 weddings as we hope that the market prices will reduce accordingly.
